If the contractor has been audited by Ohio Laborers Benefits for the period of employment you are claiming, the findings of the audit will be honored.) If you are not satisfied with the resolution of any hours discrepancies, please consult the Summary Plan Description for LDC\&C Pension Fund of Ohio and the OLDC-OCA Insurance Fund for additional details regarding your appeal rights.
